YBB's 6-9 month Building Trades Exploration program is geared towards students who need their high school equivalency diploma and are interested in participating in community building and vocational training opportunities. Young people between the ages of 17 and 24 receive:

- \$200 stipend dispersed every two weeks
- OSHA 10, First Aid/Adult CPR, NCCER, HotWorks Certifications
- HiSET preparation
- Instruction in rough carpentry, painting, landscaping, and facilities maintenance
- Weekly service learning opportunities
- Job readiness, shadowing and internship opportunities
